Matt 25:37-46 40 "And the King will answer and say to them, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me.'..."

By answering a few questions after reading, we test our immediate recall and assist our intermediate memory by further impressing people, places and events into our memories. Moreover, it is helpful to use Q&A study guides even before we begin to read. If one looks at the questions that he or she will later attempt to answer, he or she can then read with the specific goal of extracting important information from the text, which makes reading more interactive than passive. These tools are both useful and inexpensive.
