FROM THE MINISTER'S DESK:

Does Sunday Evening Service Really Count? Pt. 2

When we strive to do as Heb 10:24-25 tells us we are considering one another, provoking one another to love and good works. What does it mean to consider one another? The church is the family of God. The word "consider" means, "to give attention to; to fix our attention upon; to give continuous care; to watch over." This is how we are supposed to care one for another. Unfortunately, from time to time many neglect this essential biblical mandate and the church suffers as a result. According to the Bible, we are to love one another, John 13:34-35, care for one another, Gal. 6:2 and look after one another, Phil. 4:2.

In Hebrews 10, some were forsaken the assembling of the saints. It's believed they forsook, the assembling out of fear, persecution was rampant. In the land in which we live persecution is not rampant, and even if it was, we are still told DO NOT forsake the assembling of ourselves together. Even with this passage, many still ask themselves, and sometimes say aloud, does even service really count? David said, "I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the LORD." Psa 122:1. I don't think for David, he was glad because of the time of the day. He was glad because of the house he was in.

Does Sunday evening really count? If you don't want to come on Sunday night, then you need to stop and take a look at your relationship with God. If you're not anxious to be here Sunday morning, something isn't right between you and God. If coming to church is drudgery for you, something is wrong. And you need to get it right. Because relationships don't just get better. You've got to work at them. Including your relationship with God.

TRANSLATIONS OF THE BIBLE—THE CEV

#22 The full version of the Contemporary English Version (CEV) was made available in 1995 by the American Bible Society. It is a thought-for-thought, dynamic equivalence “translation” that employs the uncomplicated, everyday speech of modern readers. The CEV translators’ goal was to produce a version that was easily digestible for grade school aged children and second language readers. The problem, of course, is that the Bible was not written to be understood by the average grade school child. The word of God was originally delivered to stretch and expand the adult mind of people who were already familiar with biblical history and concepts. The infantilizing of the word of God inevitably leads to a great deal of interpretation being worked into the text and serious problems with inaccuracy.
