THE BOOKS OF THE BIBLE— EPHESIANS

#47 Paul wrote the epistle to the church at Ephesus, a major commercial center located in present-day Turkey. He encountered some strenuous opposition in there (Ac. 19:23-31), but the church seems to have flourished, at least for a time. Aquila, Priscilla, and Apollos were key figures in the early days of the work, and, unlike many of Paul’s letters to the churches, Ephesians does not address any particular error or heresy. The apostle seems to have written to expand the horizons of his readers, so that they might better understand the dimensions of God’s eternal purpose and appreciate His high goals for the church. Still, the church needed warning from the Lord later (Re. 2:1-7).
