FROM THE MINISTER'S DESK:

Will a Man Rob God?

How has your giving been of late? Prayerfully, it has been sacrificial, consistent, proportional and cheerful. If that is the case, you are encouraged to continue doing what you're doing. If not, then there is some work to be done.

Recently, as a congregation, we looked at the financial report, we noticed we have been doing extremely well in our giving. Let us continue and not allow the holidays or anything else come before God's business. God so loved the world that he put nothing before giving his only begotten Son. Jesus Christ so loved us that He placed nothing before his willingness to die for us. How can I then put the love of the world before God who made the world? It's easy to unintentionally put the holidays before God. Maybe you have purchased Christmas "stuff" and now you're unable to give to the Lord. Maybe you will not be in attendance during the holidays, therefore no contribution will be made. Those are some ways in which you would be putting the world before your God given responsibilities. Let's refresh our memories on some basic biblical principles on giving.

Paul said "Now concerning the collection for the saints, as I have given order to the churches of Galatia, even so do ye. Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come." 1 Cor. 16:1-2. From that we gather, giving is to be regular-on the first day of the week; giving is to be personal-each one of you; giving is the responsibility of every believer; giving is to be proportional-set aside a sum of money in keeping with his or her income. Additionally Paul says in 2 Cor. 9:7: "Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver." Our giving should be purposed and planned and it should be given cheerfully. Let us not be like those in whom Malachi spoke to when he asked "Will a man rob God?" Mal. 3:8. Let's be mindful and continue to put God first in all that we do. It was the Son of God who said "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you." Matt. 6:33.
