### Time

Time is more valuable than money. You can get more money, but you cannot get more time." (Jim Rohn). "The only reason for time is so that everything doesn't happen at once." (Albert Einstein) "Dost thou love life? Then do not squander time for that is the stuff life is made of," (Benjamin Franklin). "Time and tide wait for no man," (Walter Scott). Any man who is wise understands how to use his time to its fullest. He arranges his priorities and does first things first. He structures each day so that he gets the most out of that time he is allotted. He understands the preciousness of living each moment he has -- time is rushing by and we all must die.

THE BOOKS OF THE BIBLE—JUDE



#62 The book of Jude, penned by the half-brother of Jesus in the second half of the first century, includes numerous Old Testament references and shares a marked similarity with 2 Peter 2. The threat of false teachers compelled Jude, a key leader within the early church, to write and exhort the faithful to "earnestly contend for the faith" as it had been delivered. He discussed the character and unconscionable activities of apostates, as well as the reasons and methods for contending with them.
