FROM THE MINISTER'S DESK:

I Wish You Would Become What I Am

Paul replied, "...I pray God that not only you but all who are listening to me today may become what I am, except for these chains." Acts 26:29

Paul preached Christ to King Agrippa. He understood that he was fulfilling God's purpose for his life when he testified about the Risen Savior. He was more interested in the case for Christ than the case for Paul.

Paul prayed for a harvest--that all who listened would follow him as he was following Christ. These words challenge us to examine our lives. When we follow Christ as Paul did, we will show --the Hope of glory--to those around us. It may be easy to do this when we have no "chains" but we appreciate the way Paul lived his faith while in chains. He recognized that through the opposition of the Jews, God had given him opportunities to talk to "small and great" about the Risen Savior.

Notice what Paul said in Philippians 1:12-14 "Now I want you to know, brothers, that what has happened to me has really served to advance the gospel.

As a result, it has become clear throughout the whole palace guard and to everyone else that I am in chains for Christ. Because of my chains, most of the brothers in the Lord have been encouraged to speak the word of God more courageously and fearlessly."

What are your "chains"? Trust that God can use you--with your unique circumstances--to serve Him and to show Christ to others. Let us live so that we can say, "I want you to be like me."
