WHAT JESUS SAID ABOUT ANXIETY

Read the last 10 verses of Matthew 6. In His Sermon on the Mount, the Lord taught that His disciples should not worry about material matters. Obviously, He knew that anxiety, the fearful concern or interest in something, negatively affects us. Proverbs 12:25 says, in part, "Anxiety in the heart of man causes depression" (NKJV). If you do a little research, you will find that medical science confirms that it is emotionally and physically detrimental. Even without the research, most of us probably know this.

Read the last 10 verses of Matthew 6; Jesus taught that the level of our anxiety is related to the level of our faith. So, when we find ourselves feeling anxious, we should consider the need to walk by faith rather than by sight. When we are disquieted, or disturbed, the proper recourse is to hope in God (Ps. 42:11). That's why Paul could say, "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus" (Phil. 4:6-7 NKJV). Anxiety is the product of our taking our eyes off of God; faith is what leads us back to Him. When our anxieties grow, we can only find true peace and comfort in the Lord (Ps. 94:19).

We all worry from time to time, but that doesn't make it right. We've all been anxious about something, whether it is our health, the safety of a loved one, our financial responsibilities, or our career prospects. Without question, these matters are important. Food, shelter, and clothing are important also, but Jesus instructs us not to be anxious about them. Read the last 10 verses of Matthew 6. When we have faith in God, we don't have to worry because know that God will take care of the things we truly need.
